S. 213-A (Marchione) / A.8345 (Woerner)

AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to the "Upper Hudson Wine Trail"

The Capital Region Chamber, representing 2,500 businesses and organizations from throughout the Capital Region that employ more than 150,000 area residents, supports S.213-A/A.8345 which would designate the "Upper Hudson Wine Trail" within the "Upper Hudson American Viticultural Area" in order to promote regional agriculture.
