First Lieutenant Peter M. Gioia is currently a member of the New York Air National Guard's 109th Airlift Wing at Stratton Air National Guard Base, Scotia, where he serves as the 109th Protocol Officer as well as the Polar Plans Officer. In this position he handles all protocol related concerns for the Wing and is the Distinguished Visitor liaison to the Greenland mission. As the Polar Plans officer, he oversees the deployment of Wing personnel and equipment for Operation

DEEP FREEZE, ensuring accountability of our Airmen and the Wing's assets.

Lieutenant Gioia entered into the New York Air National Guard in July of 2004, joining the 105th Airlift Wing Fire Department. In June of 2013, he transferred to the 105th AW Logistics Readiness Squadron, where he held the roles of HAZMAT Program Manager, Unit Career Advisor, Supply Technician, LRS Safety NCOIC, Material Management Flight Training NCOIC, and Equipment Accountability Element NCOIC. He commissioned in November of 2016 when he joined the 109th Airlift Wing as a Logistics Readiness Officer. During his time at the 109th Airlift Wing he has served as the Logistics Readiness Squadron Operations Officer, Distribution Flight Officer in Charge, Polar Plans Officer, and Wing Protocol Officer.

Lieutenant Gioia obtained his Bachelor of Science Degree in Educational Studies through SUNY Empire State College. He is currently working on his Master of Arts degree in Public Administration from the University of Management and Technology. Before becoming a full-time member of the Air National Guard, Lieutenant Gioia worked as a Federal Correctional Officer and prior to that was a Logistics Manager for a non-profit organization.
