Senior Master Sergeant Gary S. Fiorillo is the 109th Air Wing/Operations Group First Sergeant, Stratton Air National Guard Base, Scotia, New York. Sergeant Fiorillo bears the responsibility for the health, morale and discipline of more than 320 Airmen. Sergeant Fiorillo serves as the commander's direct advisor on personnel programs, enlisted career progression and Professional Military Education (PME) and ensures these programs are equally balanced with personnel financial matters, and members' recognition. Sergeant Fiorillo ensures leadership, to include superintendents and supervisors, are actively engaged in the interaction, support and management of Airmen and their families through inclusive involvement and communication.

Sergeant Fiorillo enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1996 as a Generator Electrician Apprentice, serving at the Reserve Army Centers 962nd Ordnance Company, Schenectady New York. In 2003 after leaving the U.S Army Reserves, Sergeant Fiorillo enlisted with the New York Air National Guard's 109th Airlift Wing at Stratton ANG Base in Scotia, New York. While serving as the Wing Staff / Operations Group First Sergeant he deployed to several remote locations to include Afghanistan, in direct support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM, INHERENT RESOLVE, SPARTAN SHIELD, FREEDOM'S SENTINEL, and the RESOLUTE SUPPORT. In support of the 109th primary mission, employing the Department Of Defense's only ski-equipped aircraft that conducts operations in remote Polar Regions, Sergeant Fiorillo has faithfully deployed every year since 2004 in support of Operations Deep Freeze and Raven Dew accumulating over 600 days on the Antarctic Ice shelf in support of these critical and unique missions. Sergeant Fiorillo has deployed to these remote locations in several varying capacities to include Production Superintendent, First Sergeant and Barren land Survival Cadre.
