### Option A\*:

#### In-person Volunteering

(\* pending school policies)

- Virtual or in-person training (60 min).

- Ideal timeframe is about 1 lesson per week across 5 weeks.
- You and the teacher choose the schedule together.
- Volunteer Guide with talking points makes prep time minimal.
- Students learn through hands-on, interactive activities.

### Option B:

#### Virtual Volunteering

- Virtual or in-person training (60 min).
- Teach **five** 30-minute (K-1) or 45-minute (grades 2-5) separate sessions via the teachers' web conferencing link.
- Ideal timeframe is about 1 lesson per week across 5 weeks.
- You and the teacher choose the schedule together.
- Virtual volunteers engage students through screen-sharing JA materials online.
- Slides are accompanied by a detailed Volunteer Guide with talking points
- 2 screens are needed (One to view the volunteer guide and one to screen-share the slides for students).
