The Capital Region has 1.1 million people living in eight counties. The region spans 5,336 square miles, making it about the size of Connecticut. In addition to being the home of New York's capital city (Albany), the region is a major talent generator with 24 higher education institutions. Key regional industry clusters include: Cleantech, Life Sciences, Advanced Electronics/Semiconductors, R&D/Commercialization, Logistics and Distribution, Software-IT/Digital Gaming and Creative Arts, Food and Tourism (CRAFT). The Capital Region is in the middle of a major geographic zone – with New York City, Boston and Montreal a three-hour drive away. The region is brimming with opportunities for leisure and recreation, surrounded by the Catskills, Berkshires and Adirondacks and filled with arts, cultural and food destinations in between them.

- **R&D Hub:** Albany is 1 of only 51 US metros where private businesses spend more than \$1 billion annually on R&D.
- **Gateway:** The region is home to North America's northernmost, year-round water port: the Port of Albany.
