This additional funding is needed to not only overcome the multi-billion dollar hole inflation has blown in the five-year capital plan, but to invest at a level that will move our roads and bridges to a state of good repair.

Nowhere is that need more apparent than right here. Here in the Capital Region, there are nearly 2,000 lane miles of roads and almost 500 bridges in need of repair!

We are passing this along to you with a challenge to make this go viral within your company and your broader network of associates, family and even friends. We need to see a deluge of messages to the Governor and Legislature pushing the process toward the Senate's proposal.

Thanks to the leadership of Majority Leader Andrea Stewart-Cousins and Transportation Committee Chairman Tim Kennedy, the Senate Majority's transportation capital budget plan is the blueprint for how to rebuild New York roads and bridges.

The Senate Majority proposal provides \$2 billon more per year over the Governor's budget for the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) capital plan totaling \$8 billion over the next four years, as well an additional \$360 million for the state's local road system.

Tell your legislators the \$100 million in additional funding the Assembly has proposed falls far short of the road and bridge system's true needs. Without a significant increase in the NYSDOT capital budget the conditions on New York's roads and bridges will only get worse.
